This Newsletter is to thank you for your continued support for the church toilet/servery project and to update you on progress

Fund raising for our project has been a significant effort over the past 2 years and it has not been without a few 'bumps in the road'. We have been fortunate enough to receive several grant awards and the PCC has committed all available funds to the project. But, most of all, we have been inspired and encouraged by your generous giving to help reach our target of almost £100,000. That's truly amazing. Thank you.



Since our last Newsletter in November, we have been in discussion with our preferred contractor Clarke Group Ltd., regarding the practical work. It may not surprise you to hear that repricing since the tender process in June 2019 has resulted in an increase in costs. The pandemic has also resulted in sourcing issues for some materials. Although the increase in cost is small, when set against the routine running costs of the church - which are about £10,000 per year - we have needed to redouble our efforts to seek further grant funding and a possible loan. In these difficult times there is intense competition for grant funds.

We are therefore asking for your continued encouragement and generosity.
