Planning Update An application for the footpath to be diverted on the new quarry site will be submitted by 2023 in order to stop pedestrians walking through the quarry site. Planning application is being submitted for the new site by the end of the year. Trees will be planted to act as a bund in early 2023 to allow for growth ready for relocation of the site this will be included in the planning application. A low-level plant is planned to be installed on the new site to reduce the visual impact of site. Quarry Operational Update West Deeping are currently extracting material on Tinsley North. Restoration is currently taking place to restore land to low level farming. Currently soil stripping next to Mr Harvey's house to get the ground ready for archaeology as it has been confirmed a roman villa is situated in that location.
