

Deanery Synod Report 2019 (for 2020 APCM)

The highlights of this year's synods have been:

- Canon Martyn Taylor was appointed as Rural Dean. This follows on from his initial term role when he covered the vacancy following the departure of The Very Reverend Mark Warrick stood down.
- A team from the diocese came to visit to explain the statutory roles and responsibilities of PCC members as well as providing background contact for the financial issues within the Diocese of Lincoln.
- A safeguarding presentation was given to help us better understand our safeguarding responsibilities. It was stressed that the work of the church put us in contact with vulnerable adults and children (who are all classed as being vulnerable) and that we must take all practical measures to keep ourselves and all those who are vulnerable safe.
