

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 3 TALLINGTON
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2014

On 16 October 2024 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above-named Order.


The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath Number 3 in the parish of Tallington running from Main Road, Tallington at OSGR TF 0973 0864 (N) in a generally southerly direction for approximately 178 metres to terminate at OSGR TF 0975 0846 (D). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 178 metres as shown between points N-D on order plan numbered 2012/010/PPO299/A3 TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Tallington to be 2 metres in width running from Main Road, Tallington at OSGR TF 0963 0860 (O) in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 173 metres to OSGR TF 0975 0846 (D). The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 173 metres as shown between points O-D on order plan numbered 2012/010/PPO299/A3.

The Order comes into force as from 13 November 2024 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 8 November 2024 make an application to the High Court.
