Some parish councils only allow residents to do this at their Annual Parish Meeting but we have always had an 'open door' policy and allow this at all our Parish Council Meetings throughout the year. We have recently introduced an 'Open Forum' item at the start of the agenda of all our meetings, specifically for this purpose so, if you are unable to attend this Meeting, you will have further opportunities to mention any concerns that you have to us.

The current Chairperson of the Parish Council, Cllr Colin Blagrove, will chair the Annual Parish Meeting and all other parish councillors are expected to be present.

We encourage you to join us for this Meeting so that you are aware of what we do and can let us know if there is anything that you think we should be dealing with on behalf of the village.

The Annual Parish Council Meeting is scheduled for 7.30 p.m. and will commence as soon as the Annual Parish Meeting is finished, also using the Zoom technology.
